Culture Guide for: **Oncidium**  
and *Oncidium* Hybrids

**Temperature:**

Oncidiums do best in an intermediate to warm growing condition. A 55° - 64° night temperature and a 70° - 90° day temperature is considered best. Oncidiums will grow well in a normal home condition.

**Light & Shade:**

Although Oncidiums are somewhat variable in their light requirements, most should do well in bright filtered light. Morning sun (east) through a window or screen is best.

**Watering:**

During the spring and summer months Oncidiums should be watered frequently. We generally recommend watering twice a week during this period. But this may vary with different growing conditions. Do not let the plant become totally dry between watering when in bud. During fall and winter months when there is less growth curtail your water accordingly.

**Feeding:**

During the summer feed every other watering. During winter months, fertilizing should be reduced to once a month.

**Humidity:**

Oncidiums grow best with 50-80% humidity, however most varieties will tolerate a lower humidity.

**Potting:**

Repot your Oncidiums when pot bound. Usually every 2-3 years. Easy on the water for 6-8 weeks after repotting.

**Temperature:**

**Feeding:**

During the summer feed every other watering. During winter months, fertilizing should be reduced to once a month.

**Humidity:**

**Potting:**

Repot your Oncidiums when pot bound. Usually every 2-3 years. Easy on the water for 6-8 weeks after repotting.
